

Moves

Pump fake- A pump fake is a move a lot of players use and have mastered. A pump fake is used to "fake" their defender out. A pump fake is when someone acts like they are getting ready to shoot. Most of the time when someone pump fakes, their defender will react and try to block the shot. As they are doing that you can pass or actually shoot.

Moves

Behind the back pass- A behind the back pass is an effective move that a lot of players don't use. It is self explanatory, you pass behind your back with one hand. This is a good move because you can pass to your teammate without having a chance to get the pass blocked.

Scoring

Layups- There are many different ways to score in the game of basketball. A very popular way of scoring is "layups." This move allows the player to score without having to take long ranged shots. According to coachesclipboard.net, the layup is the easiest shot and the first shot you should learn in basketball. If you are left handed you should practice layups with your right hand and if you are right handed you should practice lay ups with your left hand.

Scoring

3 pointers- Behind the free throw line is the 3 point line. The 3 point line

makes and arch like this here is a drawing of half of a basketball

court:

The shot is self explanatory. If you are behind the 3 point line your shot counts as 3 points instead of two. This shot gets more points because it's farther back.

Scoring

Free throws- When someone makes contact with you as you are shooting the ball it is a foul. This is known as a shooting foul. When someone is fouled while shooting they go to the free throw line where they take 2 free throws. Each free throw counts as one point. If someone is fouled shooting a 3 pointer the person will shoot 3 free throws. Here is a diagram of when a person shoots a free throw.
